
Map of Main Campus (directions / PDF map & directions)

Parking, Transit & Carpool Information

From Interstate 5

I-5 and SR 516 / exit 149 Traffic Camera

- Coming from Seattle - take exit 149
- Coming from Tacoma - take exit 149B
- Proceed west on Kent-Des Moines Road to Pacific Highway South (Route 99)
- Turn left (south) onto Pacific Highway South
- Turn right (west) onto South 240th Street
- Entrances to East, South and Administration parking lots are on the right
- Entrance to North parking lot is off 20th Avenue South
- For Building 99 (new two-story blue/gray Outreach Center on right side of street) park in lot surrounding the building



Park in the North Parking lot and walk up the path to building 8, the Student Union building. You may take the driveway to get closer to the building to drop off people with limited mobility. We will have signs and students there to assist you.



From Interstate 5 Northbound

- Coming from Seattle - take exit 176
- Turn left onto NE 175th St. and go to Meridian Avenue N
- Turn right onto Meridian Avenue N and go to N. 185th Street
- Turn right on N. 185th and go to First Avenue NE
- Turn left on First Avenue NE. The Shoreline Center is on your right (you are at the South end of the center)

From Interstate 5 Southbound

- Coming from Everett - take exit 177
- Turn right on to NE 205th and go to First Avenue NE
- Turn left on First Avenue NE and continue south for .5 mile
- The Shoreline Center will be on your left (you are at the north end of the center)
