# CODE INTERPRETATION REQUEST

[King County Code \(K.C.C.\) Chapter 2.100](#) allows anyone to formally apply to King County for a written code interpretation of development regulations. An interpretation may be requested for a specific development proposal, as part of a code enforcement case, or for the general application of a specific King County Code section. Development codes include K.C.C. Titles 9,14, 16, 19A, 20, 21A, and 23. DDES is responsible for administering Titles 16, 17, 19A, 20, 21A, and 23. A request to interpret a code not administered by DDES should be made to the department that administers that code.

To apply for a code interpretation from DDES, complete this form, including a description of your request, and submit it to the DDES Permit Center at the address above, along with your fee payment. As of January 1, 2004, the fee is \$250.00. You will be notified within 15 days whether your request complies with the requirements for a code interpretation request. DDES will generally issue a code interpretation within 60 days. If the request involves a currently pending permit, any individuals or organizations who have expressed an interest in the permit will be notified of the request and have an opportunity to provide information. The code interpretation will be mailed to you and will also be posted on the King County DDES Web site at [www.kingcounty.gov/permits](http://www.kingcounty.gov/permits).
