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2005-6 Care Services Prioritization/Allocation Process Funding Caveats and Subpriorities

- 1. Ambulatory / Outpatient Medical Care** **\$ 797,000 – Level Funding**
Caveat: *Favorable consideration will be given to programs that demonstrate: (A) existing and/or proposed strategies to train medical staff to assess and discuss sexual and drug use risk reduction issues with clients and, (B) incorporation into medical services delivery of client-centered sexual and drug use risk reduction counseling and/or referral and follow-up.*

- 2. ADAP** **\$ 350,000 – Level Funding**
No caveats or sub-priorities

- 3. Case Management** **\$ 1,240,000 – Level Funding**
Caveat: *Favorable consideration will be given to programs that incorporate HIV prevention interventions into case management service delivery and deliver consistent, research-based risk reduction messages.*

- 4. Housing** **\$ 1,015,000 – Increase of \$50,000.**
Subpriority 1: *\$ 150,000 reserved for emergency rental assistance.*
Subpriority 2: *\$ 180,000 reserved for emergency housing vouchers.*
Subpriority 3: *\$ 65,000 reserved to provide service-enriched transitional housing support including, but not limited to, mental health therapy, substance use therapy, protective payee services, life skills training, etc., in order to facilitate clients' ability to successfully move into stable, permanent housing.*

- 5. Oral Health Care** **\$ 205,000 – Level Funding**
Caveat 1: *Favorable consideration will be given to vendors who provide specialty care (i.e. crowns, root canals, bridges, etc.) as part of their overall services.*

- 6. Insurance Programs** **\$ 100,000 – Level Funding**
No caveats or sub-priorities

- 7. Mental Health** **\$ 300,000 – Decrease of \$35,000**
Directive to the grantee: *The grantee is asked to negotiate with mental health providers to expand the number of visits allowed for severely needy clients.*
Subpriority 1: *\$ 25,000 reserved for bilingual and bicultural services to Latino/as.*
Caveat 1 was dropped and replaced with subpriority 1, due to the caveat needs assessment that indicated that subpriorities were more effective than caveats.

- 8. Food Bank/Home-Delivered Meals** **\$ 252,000 – Level Funding**
Subpriority 1: *\$ 25,000 reserved for emergency grocery vouchers.*
No caveats.

9. Psychosocial Support **\$135,000 – Decrease of \$15,000**
 No caveats or subpriorities.
10. Treatment Adherence Support **\$ 35,000 – Decrease of \$10,000**
 Minority Initiative: **\$ 55,000 – Decrease of \$2,316***
 No caveats or subpriorities.
11. Alternative Therapies **\$ 133,000 – Decrease of \$18,000**
 No caveats or subpriorities.
12. Transportation **\$ 40,000 – Decrease of \$15,000**
 No caveats or subpriorities.
13. Day/Respite Care for Adults **\$ 220,000 – Decrease of \$6,000**
Caveat: Applicants may not apply for funding through this RFP in other categories for specific components of their programs if such components are included in the Day/Respite Care for Adults definition.
14. Substance Use Treatment **\$ 165,000 – Level Funding**
 Subpriority : **\$ 50,000** minimum reserved for methadone treatment programs.
Caveat: Favorable consideration given to proposals that demonstrate increased outreach/access to recently incarcerated persons.
15. Emergency Financial Assistance **\$ 25,000 – Level Funding**
 No caveats or subpriorities.
16. Planning Council Support **\$ 256,000 – Increase \$3000**
 No caveats or subpriorities.
17. Legal Services **\$ 7,000 – Level Funding**
 No caveats or subpriorities.
18. Client Advocacy **\$ 0 – Level Funding**
 Minority Initiative: **\$ 85,000 – Decrease of \$87,684***
 No caveats or subpriorities.
19. Referral for Health Services **\$ 85,000 – Decrease of \$7,000**
 No caveats or subpriorities.
20. Health Education/Risk **\$ 0 – Level Funding**
 Minority Initiative: **\$ 85,000 – Increase of \$85,000***
 No caveats or subpriorities.
21. Home Health Care **\$ 100,000 – Decrease of \$40,000**
 No caveats or subpriorities.
22. Buddy/Companion Care **\$ 0 – Level Funding**
23. Childcare **\$ 0 – Level Funding**
- Not Ranked. Outreach** **\$ 15,000 – Increase of \$15,000**
Caveat: Favorable consideration will be given to providers who use an outreach model proven through research to be effective.

* Minority Initiative Funding: Applicants may put in one application which can cover one, two or all three of the service categories in which MAI funds were prioritized.
