LANDSCAPE NOTES

- TREE AND SHRUB LOCATIONS ARE DETERMINING. ADJUST AS REQUIRED TO ACCOMMODATE FIELD CONDITIONS AS DIRECTED BY THE TECHNICAL REPRESENTATIVE OR OWNER. ROOT BALLS OR WHITE SEED SHALL BE PLACED UP TO SHRUB AND TREE ROOT BALL.
 - CONTRACTOR SHALL CLEAR, GRUB AND PULL ROOTS FROM ALL AREAS WITHIN LIMITS OF CLEARING AND GRUBBING OF ALL WEEDS, HAZARDOUS BLACKBERRY, SCOTS BROOM AND OTHER NON-NATIVE/INVASIVE VEGETATION. PROTECT AND PRESERVE EXISTING VEGETATION SCHEDULED TO REMAIN.
 - CONTRACTOR SHALL RESTORE ALL AREAS DISTURBED DUE TO CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS. PREPARE AND RESTORE PER THE SPECIFICATIONS.
 - PLACE MULCH WITHIN TREE AND SHRUB PLANTING PITS PER THE DETAILS AND SPECIFICATIONS.
 - SET PLANTING DETAILS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR RELATED WORK AS PART OF THIS CONTRACT.
 - ALL AREAS TO BE DISTURBED WITHIN CLEARING AND GRUBBING LIMITS TO BE HYDRPOSEED WITH NATIVE RESTORATION SEED MIX UNLESS OTHERWISE SHOWN. BASE BID, THIS SHEET ONLY, TO INCLUDE CLEARING AND GRUBBING, LANDSCAPE RESTORATION PLANNING, AND TRAIL CONSTRUCTION AS SHOWN.
 - ADDITIVE ALTERNATE # 2, THIS SHEET ONLY, TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL AREAS OF CLEARING AND GRUBBING AND ADDITIONAL LANDSCAPE RESTORATION PLANNING.
 - ADA ACCESSIBLE TRAIL SHALL BE MIN. 48" WIDE AND MAX. 5% SLOPE. VERRY GRADE CONDITIONS CAN BE MET 72 HOURS PRIOR TO BASE COURSE PREPARATION.
- LANDSCAPE PERMIT REQUIREMENTS**
- BASED ON KCC 21A.16.030 F, THE PROPOSED USE IS NOT SUBJECT TO LANDSCAPING AND TREE RETENTION REQUIREMENTS.
 - PER KCC 21A.16.070, THE PROPOSED USE IS NEITHER RESIDENTIAL OR COMMERCIAL AND THEREFORE NOT SUBJECT TO LANDSCAPING REQUIREMENTS FOR SURFACE PARKING SET FORTH IN KCC 21A.16.070.
 - ALL LANDSCAPING SHOWN IS NOT REQUIRED FOR PERMIT.
 - PER KCC 21A.18.110C, AN 18" WIDE CLEARANCE AREA IS REQUIRED ADJACENT TO PARKING SPACES. ALL LANDSCAPING SHALL BE COATED AS TO PERMIT THIS 18" CLEARANCE AREA ADJACENT TO PARKING SPACES UPON MATURE GROWTH OF PLANT MATERIAL.
