

This Concert is a fundraiser to provide assistance to those affected by the recent and severe wind and rain storms that impacted the Puget Sound region.

Did you know that after a disaster, your Governor needs to request disaster relief from the President before FEMA will disburse aid? Did you also know that recent amendments in October 2006 limits FEMA's aid to you to a maximum of \$28,200 per fiscal year? According to Governor Gregoire's recent request for disaster relief on January 11, 2007, "survey teams found an estimated \$47 million in eligible damages" in the 19 counties where disaster relief is sought. That's more than six times the amount of damage needed for aid consideration. Relief has yet to be determined, and the claims process is reportedly difficult.

The National Association of Women in Construction (NAWIC) wants to assist homeowners in need of construction improvements as a direct result of the recent wind and rain storms, and in particular, those who have damages that have created financial hardship due to being underinsured, or not covered by insurance policy or FEMA assistance.
