

- December 06 windstorm & power-outage revealed sheltering weaknesses
- February, 07 Summit I formed a workgroup to work shelter typing and planning.
- Shelter typing by workgroup complete; socialization and by-in by jurisdictions needed.

# Planning Issues

- **Goal is to add “Shelter Typing Table” to each KC Government and cities CEMP, ESF-6**
- **Because of resource constraints, each city is unable to support its own dormitory shelter.**
- **Warming/Cooling Centers can be supported by each city with information on the disaster event and locations of other ‘types’ of shelters.**
- **Overall need to leverage resources (example: libraries for Warming/Cooling Centers)**

- ESF-6 Changes

# Regional Sheltering Resources

- 12,000 cots and blankets-region wide
- New purchases: 2200 cots/4400 blankets

Trained staff

- Training classes from ARC, WASART, HSUS
